

## Helpful SWSC COVID Information

To our SWSC club members and coaches:

As we begin our new season, COVID-19 will present us with a unique skating season. Please read through these guidelines which have been provided by the City of Windsor.

### A: Check In:

- If you feel unwell please do not come to the facility.
- Participants must come dressed with their equipment on (excluding skates/gloves/helmets) as there is no change of clothes permitted on city premises (Rink, parking lot etc.)
- Each session grouping must remain outside (while maintaining physical distancing) until the entire group is on site and ready to enter while wearing their masks. A club volunteer or coach will be present to collect the daily COVID Health Screening Questionnaire.
- Entrance to the facility will be through the West Parking Lot Main Entrance Only - 15 minutes prior to booking time (with a 5 minute grace period). The North and South Lobby doors will be used to Exit Only.
- Each skater is permitted to be accompanied into the rink by 1 guardian. No other siblings or spectators are permitted in the stands.
- No outside food or drinks allowed (except prefilled water bottles as water fountains will not be available).
- Proper physical distancing must be maintained at all times.

### B: Be Prepared:

- Arriving early at the arena means you are on time this year.
- Each session will be allowed into the building 15 minutes prior to the start of their session.
- All groups will be ushered into the building and directed to specific seating areas to get ready.
- Change rooms or seating areas will be provided for putting on and taking off of skates/helmets only. There will be no changing of clothing allowed.

- Water/Showers in the change rooms will be turned off. General public washrooms will be available.
- Masks must be worn at all times in the building except when the helmet with a mask/shield is on, or until the skater is entering the ice.
- Markings on floors direct traffic through the building. Direction arrows are on the floor every 6 feet. Round-a-bouts are located at intersections of hallways. Respect the rules and the space of others by ensuring proper physical distancing.
- Markings are on the floor in the viewing areas to indicate where to stand for social distancing.
- Guardians may view from locations marked by “Stand Here” signs in the lobby or “Sit Here” signs in designated sections of the stands.

#### C: Check Out

- Exit through the North or South Lobby Doors.
- Vacate the building within 15 minutes of leaving the ice.
- No loitering in or around the building or in the parking lot.
- No changing of clothing is permitted on city premises.
