



Dear South Windsor Skating Club Families,

The South Windsor Skating Club takes the safety of all skaters and coaches very seriously. The Board of Directors will be releasing an updated Covid-19 Return to Skating Policy on our website within the next week. Please visit our website regularly for updates, and read the new policy under the posts section of the website.

At this time, the City of Windsor has announced that all city recreation facilities will be closed as of Monday, November 30 for a two week period. The city will reassess the Covid-19 situation every 2 weeks. With this announcement, all South Windsor Skating Club activities will be put on hold temporarily.

If in the near future ice becomes available, we will make every effort to return to skating as quickly as possible. If skating resumes while under the Red Zone restrictions, there will be 8 skaters and 2 coaches per session. Ice times will be assigned by program, coach availability and ice availability.

All Uplifter payments will continue as planned. Credits will be calculated for all accounts once the period of inactivity has ended. This will allow us to return to the ice as soon as possible.

The fudge fundraiser order has been placed. Once there is a confirmed delivery date, plans will be made to pick-up or deliver the fudge to those families who participated in the fundraiser.
