

South Windsor Skating Club COVID-19 Policy



The South Windsor Skating Club (SWSC) COVID-19 Policy has been developed in order to clearly state the expectations of SWSC members with respect to COVID-19.

1. All SWSC members must inform their coach and the club president (Paul van Heugten) if they are required to isolate due to suspected exposure or a confirmed case of COVID-19. This information will be kept confidential.
2. After a suspected exposure to COVID-19, the individual should not participate in club/skating school activities for 14 days and should follow public health guidelines regarding self-isolation and testing. The individual can resume skating/club activities after receiving medical clearance from the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit or their family doctor.
3. After a confirmed positive case of COVID-19, the 14 day period of isolation will continue as directed by the health unit. As the individual remains in isolation, the individual will refrain from participating in club activities until they are cleared by the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit.
4. In all cases, the individuals must inform the South Windsor Skating Club 24 hours prior to returning to the arena.
5. If an individual has other symptoms of illness, eg. common cold symptoms, the individual must refrain from participating in club activities and may return 48 hours after the symptoms are no longer present.
6. The club will also inform all of its members, the facility and Skate Ontario of the fact that there is a positive COVID-19 diagnosis within the club yet all information will be kept confidential. Following a positive COVID-19 test, an individual must follow all public health guidelines regarding return to activities.

This policy is subject to change without notification and will be based on public health directives.
